

PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

A Three-Part Webinar Series to Explore Legal and Financial Options

When your child turns 18, they have the legal right to make decisions for themselves. This series will explore options available for people who have disabilities so they and their families can make informed decisions about their future.

Part 1: Guardianship

People who are over 18 years old and have disabilities may benefit from a legally appointed guardian's assistance in making personal, medical or financial decisions. We will examine the requirements, processes and protections for a person who has a disability under 17A Guardianship in New York. Determining who can be a guardian will also be discussed.

Part 2: Power of Attorney & Health Care Proxy

An alternative to 17A Guardianship is power of attorney. We will discuss differences between 17A Guardianship and power of attorney, and explore health care decision-making authority.

Part 3: ABLÉ Accounts

For the first time, people with disabilities and their families will be allowed to establish ABLÉ Accounts, tax-advantaged savings accounts that will not affect their eligibility for public benefits. We will examine ABLÉ accounts and discuss the advantages.
